this reception history of the gospel of matthew utilizes theoretical frameworks and literary sources from two typically distinct disciplines patristic studies and valentinian a k a gnostic studies the author shows how in the second and third centuries the valentinians were important contributors to a shared culture of early christian exegesis by examining the use of the same matthean pericopes by both valentinian and patristic exegetes the author

demonstrates that certain valentinian exegetical innovations were influential upon and ultimately adopted by patristic authors chief among valentinian contributions include the allegorical interpretation of texts that would become part of the new testament a sophisticated theory of the historical and theological relationship between christians and jews and indeed the very conceptualization of the gospel of matthew as sacred scripture this study demonstrates that what would eventually emerge from this period as the ecclesiological and theological center cannot be adequately understood without attending to some groups and individuals that have often been depicted both by subsequent ecclesiastical leaders and modern scholars as marginal and heretical

and expectations the emphasis lays on hermetism in antiquity and its influence in the middle ages the renaissance and the early modern period the 14 contributions were written by r van den broek 3 c gilly 2 p kingsley 2 j p mahl 1 and g quispel 6 the book contains discussions of several aspects of the hermetic and gnostic tradition such as hermetic religious practices magic alchemy apocalyptic visions and the influence of hermetic ideas on early christian and medieval theologians the volume is of interest for students of graeco roman religiosity early christianity medieval theology and the hermetic traditions in the renaissance and later western culture

this book presents the first comprehensive interpretation of the paraphrase of shem codex vii 1 in the coptic nag hammadi library the lengthy introduction discusses the literary genre of the treatise its plan and system its situation among the gnostic systems its provenance and date the translation sets out the text in paragraphs with headings and subheadings a short commentary follows the translation the analysis of the system shows that the author is working from a model of the universe whose principles have been drawn from stoicism and middle platonism while dipping into the springs of the major sethian and valentinian systems the author follows his own way and offers an original system anticipating in many respects manichaeism

scholars of early christian and jewish literature have for many years focused on interpreting texts in their hypothetical original forms and contexts while largely overlooking important aspects of the surviving manuscript evidence and the culture that produced it this volume of essays seeks to remedy this situation by focusing on the material aspects of the manuscripts themselves and the fluidity of textual transmission in a manuscript culture with an emphasis on method and looking at texts as they have been used and transmitted in manuscripts this book discusses how we may deal with textual evidence that can often be described as mere snapshots of fluid textual traditions that have been intentionally adapted to fit ever shifting contexts the emphasis of the book is on the contexts and interests of users and producers of texts as they appear in our surviving manuscripts rather than on original authors and their intentions and the essays provide both important correctives to former textual interpretations as well as new insights into the societies and individuals that copied and read the texts in the manuscripts that have actually been preserved to us

the first christians operated with a hierarchical model of sexual difference common to the ancient mediterranean with women considered to be lesser versions of men yet sexual difference was not completely stable as a conceptual category across the spectrum of formative christian thinking rather early christians found ways to exercise theological creativity and to think differently from one another as they probed the enigma of sexually differentiated bodies in specters of paul benjamin h dunning explores this variety in second and third century christian thought with particular attention to the ways the legacy of the apostle paul fueled shaped and also constrained approaches to the issue paul articulates his vision of what it means to be human

primarily by situating human beings between two poles creation adam and resurrection christ but within this framework where does one place the figure of eve and the difference that her female body represents dunne demonstrates that this dilemma impacted a range of christian thinkers in the centuries immediately following the apostle including clement of alexandria irenaeus of lyons tertullian of carthage and authors from the nag hammadi corpus while each of these thinkers attempts to give the difference of the feminine a coherent place within a pauline typological framework dunne shows that they all fail to deliver fully on the coherence that they promise instead sexual difference haunts the pauline discourse of identity and sameness as the difference that can be neither fully assimilated nor fully ejected a conclusion with important implications not only for early christian history but also for feminist and queer philosophy and theology
